

DATA PROTECTION POLICY

This Privacy Policy (hereinafter: “Policy”) describes how Kommunitas collect, store, use, and manage any Personal Data and Anonymous Data (hereinafter: “Information”) you provide to us, or we collect in connection with your use of Kommunitas website (hereinafter: “site”) accessible at <https://kommunitas.net/> and our other websites on which this Policy appears (hereinafter: the Site).

By using the Site you agree to this Data Protection Policy and the processing of your data, including your personal information, in the manner provided in this Policy. If you do not agree to the terms of this Policy, please do not use the Site.

1. Website Use

When you access or use this website, your usage is bounded by the terms of this Privacy Policy. Kommunitas has the full discretion to review the Privacy Policy without prior notice, and reserves the right to change the Privacy Policy at any time by posting such changes on the website. The changes made on our Privacy Policy and Terms of Use will be effective immediately after the update on the website. Your continued use of the website will be construed to mean you have fully accepted the changes in totality. This Privacy Policy is strictly restricted to the use of Kommunitas website, and does not, in any way, apply to websites that are linked to the website and over which Kommunitas has no control over their operations or actions.

2. Personal Data

For purposes that will be mentioned further in this Policy, we may process and/or collect the following information that can be used to identify you as an individual (hereinafter: “Personal Data”), including name, email address, location data, and IP address. We do not sell or share your personal data with any third-party. The data is purely for Kommunitas’s use to identify you, maintain your user account, upgrade and enhance your experience within the website, and provide you services according to the terms of agreement.

3. Email address.

You may explicitly decline to submit Personal Data through the Site, in which case we will not be able to provide to you our newsletters and other updates via email.

4. Anonymous Data Collected Automatically

We collect non-personally identifiable information that alone or in combination with similar information cannot be used to identify you (hereinafter: “Anonymous Data”) from your computer, mobile device, or browser when you use the Site as a logged-in user. The Site automatically collects usage information, such as:

- a) Your IP address
- b) The type of device you use
- c) Browser type, version, and language

- d) Type and version of your operating system
- e) Your activity on the Site
- f) The number and frequency of visitors to the Site

We may collect Anonymous Data or use third-party services for that, for example, web analytics services. This Anonymous Data is not linked to Personal Data.

5. Third-Parties Tracking Technologies

This Policy does not cover the use of cookies and other similar technologies by third parties. For example, we may use third-party analytic services to collect information about the use of the Site or the Site may contain links leading to other sites. We do not control when or how third parties place cookies on your computer. For example, third-party websites to which link points may set cookies on your computer or analytic services may do the same. These cookies or other similar technologies may be used to track your behavior on other websites, and we have no control over this.

6. Why We Collect Information

The Information is used for:

- a) Delivering you the Site and its functionality
- b) Your seamless interaction with the Site
- c) Analytical and statistical purposes
- d) Understanding your interaction with the Site
- e) Improvement and development of the Site or our other services and products
- f) Enforcement of this Policy and the Terms
- g) Sending you related information, including newsletters, special offers, confirmations, updates, and security alerts

7. Duration of Retaining of the Information

We will keep your Information for as long as you remain a user and, thereafter, for no longer than is reasonably necessary for reporting and reconciliation purposes pursuant to legal requirements.

8. Your Consent

You expressly consent to our processing, collection, transfer, storage, disclosure, and other uses of your Information as described in this Policy and the Terms of Use at the instance when you provide information to us through the Site and/or accept this Policy. In addition, through this use and interactions with the Site you specifically consent to:

- a) Our collection of information by automated means and to our subsequent

processing and using of information in accordance with this Policy

- b) The storage and transfer of information to locations wherever we and our service providers have facilities.

9. Disclosure of Information

We may release the Information concerning your use of the Site:

- a) To provide you with the services and functionality of the Site;
- b) In case it is set out in the Terms of Use;
- c) When we believe in good faith that such release is appropriate to comply with the applicable law, regulation, legal process, or governmental request;
- d) To enforce this Policy and/or the Terms of Use, or any agreement between you and us;
- e) To detect, prevent, or otherwise address fraud, security, or technical issues;
- f) To protect against the abusive or unlawful use of the Site;
- g) To protect the rights, safety, or property of users or any other third parties;
- h) In other ways described in this Policy and the Terms of Use;

10. With Whom We Share Personal Data

We may share Personal Data only under any of the circumstances mentioned in this Policy and/or the Terms of Use. We will not share any Personal Data provided by you except with service providers under contract who help with our business operations, such as providers of marketing automation, information management, and analytics services and products.

11. Business or Asset Transfer

In the event that we, a line of our business, or substantially all our assets are transferred, sold, or merged with another business, Information may be one of the transferred assets.

12. Security of Personal Data

We will take commercially reasonable precautions to protect Personal Data from loss, misuse, and unauthorized access, disclosure, alteration, and destruction. We process all Information using industry-standard techniques. We implement the following administrative, technical, and physical measures for the protection of Personal Data:

- a) Administrative measures. Access to your Personal Data is limited to authorized personnel who have a legitimate need to access it based on their job

descriptions. In case third-party contractors process Personal Data on our behalf, similar requirements are imposed.

- b) Technical measures. Personal Data is transmitted in encrypted format using SSL technology. We use up-to-date firewall protection and high-quality antivirus and anti-malware software.
- c) Physical measures. We store Personal Data on our own servers, no third party can have access to this data.

However, we do not guarantee or warrant that such techniques will prevent unauthorized access to Information, including Personal Data that we store.

13. Modifications

We may modify or revise this Policy at any time by posting the amended Policy on the Site. Please check the most current Policy.

14. Changing or Updating Your Personal Data

We rely on you to advise us about any changes to your Personal Data. Please contact us as soon as possible if there are any changes to your Personal Data or if you believe the Personal Data we hold about you is not accurate, complete, or up-to-date so that we can update our records accordingly.
